The Council of the Village of Millbury met in regular session on the above date at the Millbury Council Chambers with Mike Timmons, Mayor, presiding.

Council Members present: Abbey, Clapsaddle, Ellison, Mangus, Mikolajczyk and Clapsaddle.

Motion by Sanders to approve the May 11, 2026 meeting minutes. Seconded by Mikolajczyk. Roll Call: all yea! Motion carried.

Police Department: per Lake Township Police Officer

Fire Department: Councilman Sanders
For April there were 4 EMS and for May there were 10 EMS.

Public Input:
Matt Lassiter gave a brief update on the disc golf.

Street Commissioner – Mike Sanders
There has been no word by Thomas Lutes who was hired by the Village at the May Council meeting. The concrete is crumbling at the Walters household on Michelle. This must not have been fixed when the street was redone on Michelle. The older bleachers are being disassembled and brimstone will be laid down on the streets in the village. Mosquito spraying will start when necessary.

Park Commissioner: per Mike Densic
There is two more weeks of summer softball. The men's restroom stall has been damaged. There is no door on the stall until the part gets here. Flowers are all planted. Park Commissioner Densic has been working on painting the restroom doors and working on the memorial.

Zoning Commissioner: by Zoning Commissioner Mravoich
A driveway and fence permit have been issued.

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Old Business:

The 2024/2025 audit is still being completed.

We received a Stormwater Management invoice from the county for \$4,000.00. Last year we paid \$838.00. Clerk Densic checked with DGL and they will charge \$10,000.00 to do it. Councilman Sanders will check this out and Clerk Densic will ask for an official breakdown of services.

Bob Desmond from DGL discussed the OPWC funding source for street repairs in the Village. After discussing with Councilman Abbey, the three streets that need the most work are Pam, Earl and Snyder. Mr. Desmond broke it down into three options:

- Option 1: \$510,000.00 (\$250,000.00 grant or local share/\$250,000 0% interest loan)
- Option 2: \$400,000.00 (\$200,000.00 grant or local share/\$200,000 0% interest loan)
- Option 3: Just repave over everything. The least expensive option.

All options include engineering. Much Discussion ensued.

Motion by Sanders to go with Option 1. Second by Abbey. Roll Call: all yea! Motion carried.

New Business:

Ordinance No. 812

An Ordinance Adopting a Cybersecurity Policy for the Village of Millbury, Ohio, in Accordance with Ohio Revised Code 9.64

Motion by Sanders to pass Ord. 812 as an emergency. Second by Mikolajczyk. Roll Call: all yeah! Motion carried.

Motion by Clapsaddle to suspend the rules and give Ord. 812 its 2nd and 3rd readings by title only. Second by Mangus. Roll Call: all yeah! Motion carried.

Motion by Sanders to place Ord. 812 on its passage. Second by Clapsaddle. Roll Call: all yeah! Motion carried.
